They were placed in a grave a mere stone's throw from the Museum and speak of contact some 4,000 years ago between people living in Kilmartin Glen and those in mainland Europe.



In the new Museum the plaques will form part of an installation on the floor of the reception area. A bronze River Add will flow from one side of the room to the other and each monument will be marked with a plaque, relative to its original location. Each plaque will feature an interpretation of the artefacts from the monument that it represents, or, in the case of the rock art sites, an interpretation of the rock art itself. Unless you wish to remain anonymous, your name will be inscribed on the plaque of your choice, and will be a part of the bronze floor map at the entrance to the new Museum.
